INTRODUCTION

Qingdao is a cradle of the Chinese contemporary sailing sport with unique sailing condition and talent advantages. It hosted the sailing events of the 29th Olympic Games and the 13th Paralympic Games in 2008. Taking advantage of the Olympic Sailing competition, Qingdao Municipal Government set the strategic target of building up the Sailing City of China and officially launched the program of Promoting Sailing in Schools in 2006. Through 11-year efforts, 107 sailing-featured schools have been built, including 32 sailing-featured model schools. 1,080 boats of different types have been bought for promoting sailing and more than 27,000 students have been trained. A functional system, with the guidance of the government, the support of society and wide participation of the youth has been formed. Qingdao was awarded the Model City for Promoting Youth Sailing by the Chinese Yachting Association (CYA). The great development in youth sailing was spoken highly by Mr. Jacques Rogge, former President of the IOC and Mr. Göran Pettersson, former President of the ISAF (now World Sailing), as well as Mr. Peter Barclay, President of International Optimist Dinghy Association (IODA).

With the support of IODA and CYA, Qingdao initiated the Training Camp & Regatta in 2010, and kept it as an annual international event from then on. By 2016, a total of 2,400 teenage sailors from more than twenty countries and regions, including Germany, France, Spain, Russia, New Zealand, U.S.A., South Africa, Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, Korea, Japan, Burma, Pakistan, India, Hong Kong and Taiwan as well as cities of Mainland China, have participated in the event. The intensive but exciting training program, the dialogue with international sailing celebrities, the colorful cultural activities and the high-level regatta leave an unforgettable memory for the young sailors.

The Qingdao International Optimist Training Camp & Regatta 2017 will be held from August 10th to 17th during the 9th Qingdao International Sailing Week - Qingdao International Marine Festival. We cordially invite excellent Optimist sailors and coaches from all around the world to join us in the Camp & Regatta.
